Abstract

The record book is designed, according to an inscription at the beginning of the book, as a "Church Register, in which are to be enrolled the names of its members. Instead of the usual method of transcribing it annually, simply mark the changes and then the standing of the church will be seen for years." After listing the trustees and official members of the church, there follow lists of members with deaths, expulsions, members dropped, married names added, and transfers. In addition, there are some financial notes, minutes of a church conference held on July 7, 1907, minutes of a church meeting held May 13, 1877, brief notes of several other meetings, a list of teachers and Sunday School officers, and what appears to be a list of money assessed to certain members.

Historical Note

Hebron Church was chartered in 1854 by members of Mt. Zion Methodist Episcopal Church so that members could have a church closer to their homes. It joined the Currituck Charge along with Mt. Zion Methodist, and several others, in 1926. Today it continues to be part of the Currituck Charge of The United Methodist Church.

Chronology

This record book covers the years of 1875-1907

Scope and Content Note

There is only one record book with membership records covering the period of about 1875-1885, according to notations. There are detailed minutes from a 1907 meeting as

well as an 1877 meeting, along with short meeting notes for several other meetings. Drawings in the book probably are from a later date.

Arrangement of Collection

The record book is not totally in chronological order. The meeting minutes from 1907 are before the 1877 ones. But the membership lists are apparently chronological.
